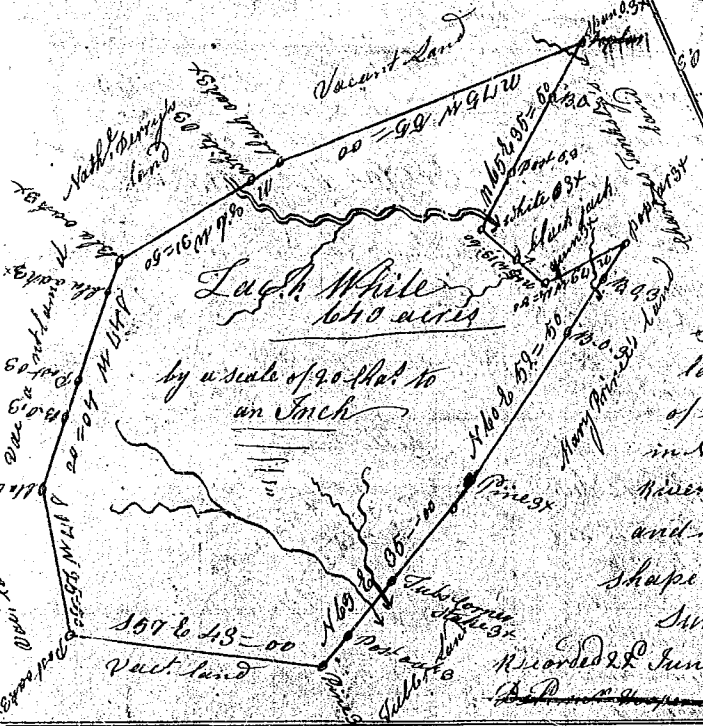
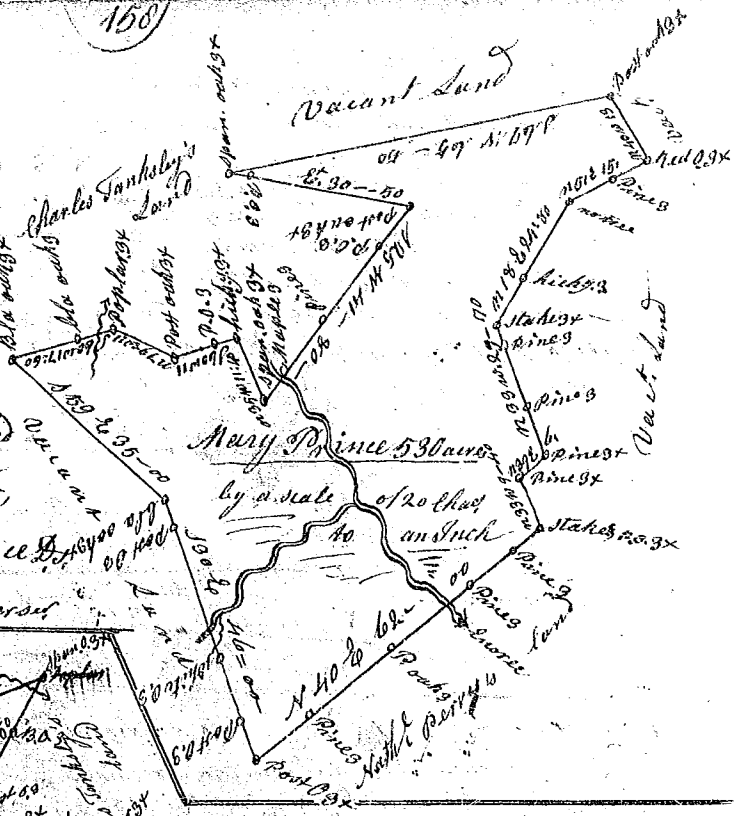


State of South Carolina,
