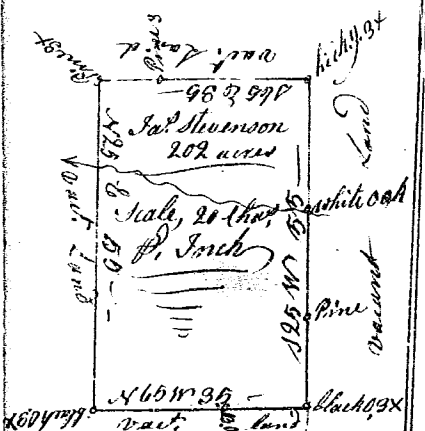


East 880 Chains
