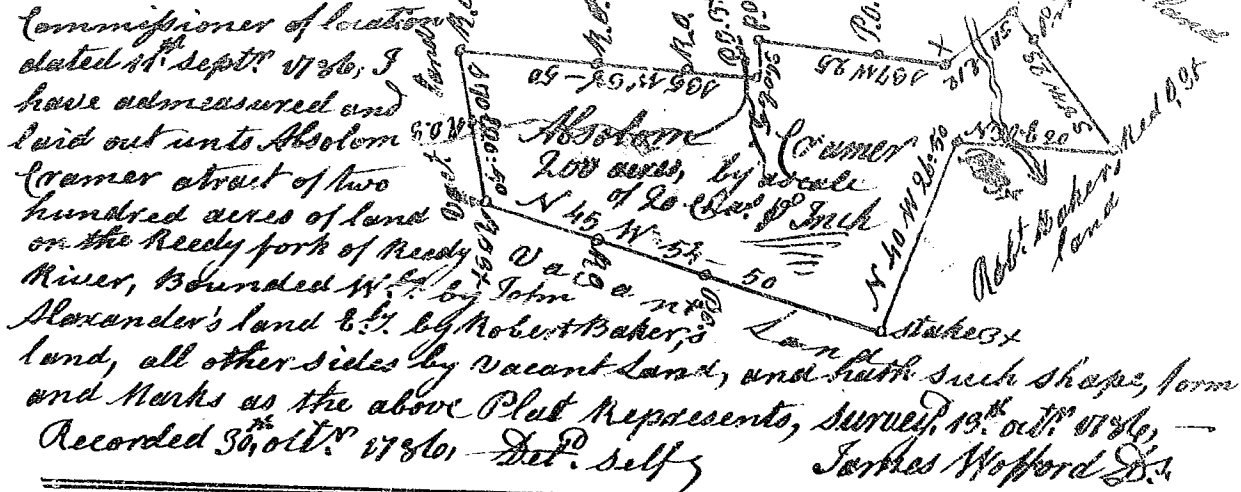
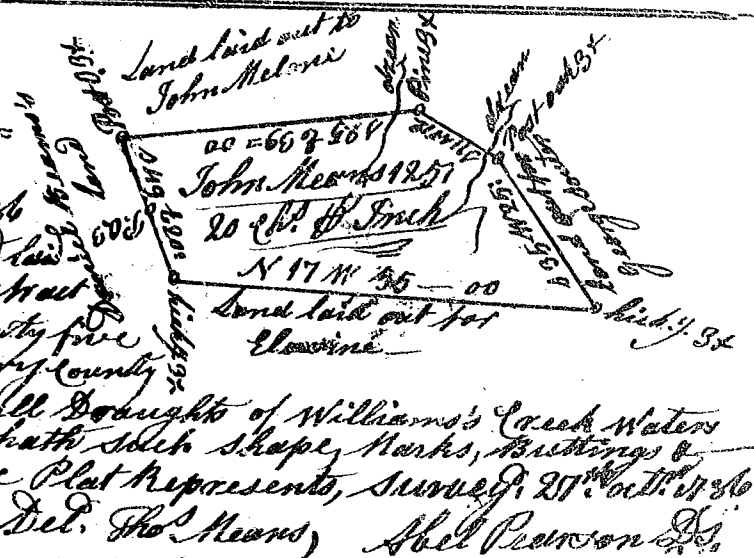


State of South Carolina 96 District John Alexander's
