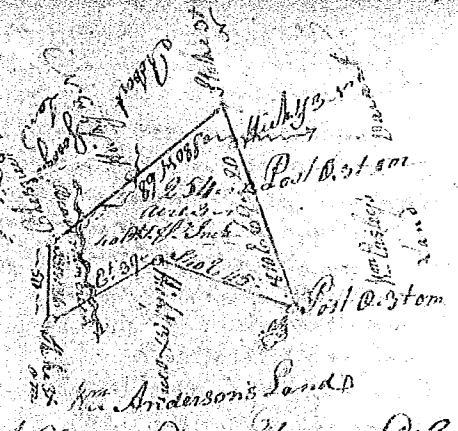


State of South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from

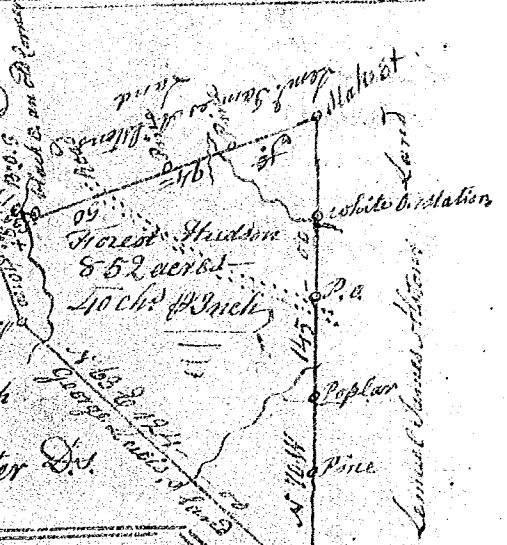
