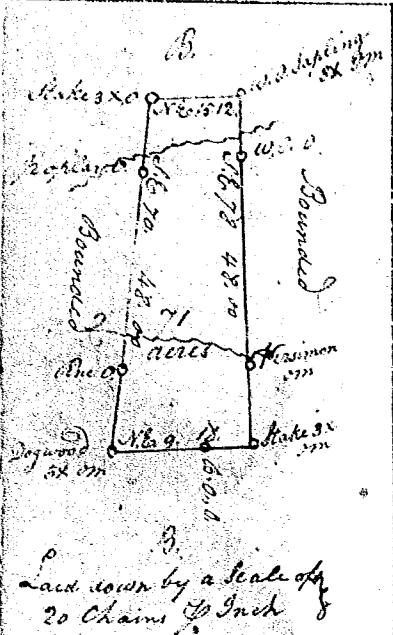


State of S. Carolina
