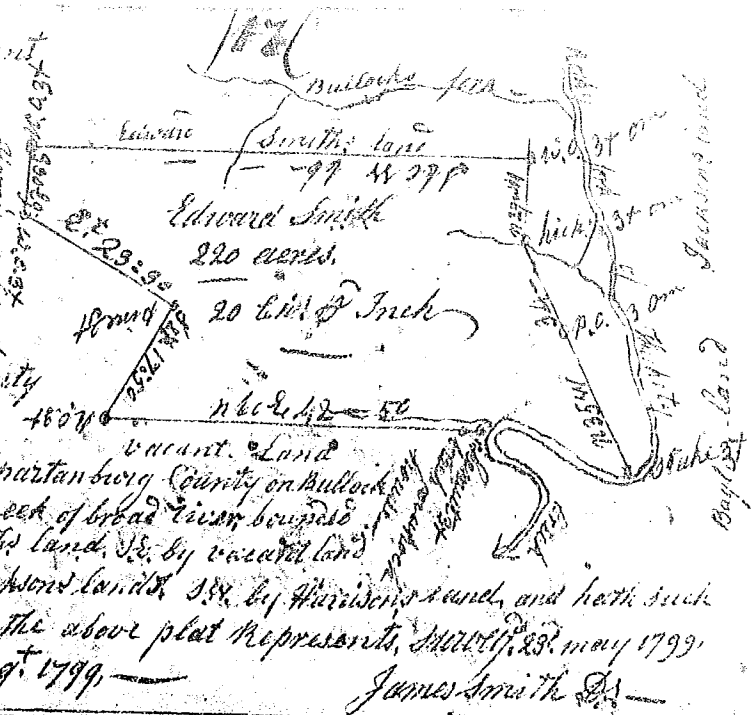


St Carolina Pursuant
