Pursuant to a warrant from Wm. Thomas  
 Com. Genl for the district of Greenville dated  
 the 20<sup>th</sup> of October 1812 I have admeasured &  
 laid out unto Richard Madden, a tract of One hun-  
 dred & Seventy acres of land, situate in the S. district  
 on one of the head branches of the Peedy Fork - water  
 of Peedy River, bounded by lines running N 68° 30' E by  
 Richard Madden's land & 100 m Cores - N 68° 30' E by  
 Cores - S W by John Rice's - & S E by unknown or vacant  
 land - And hath such form & marks as the above plat  
 represents.
