Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esquire Commissioner of Locations for Greenville District, dated the 12th day of April 1816, I have measured and laid out ~~to~~ Archibald Taylor a tract of one hundred & twelve acres of Land situate in Greenville District on a branch of Bush Creek waters of Sugar River bounded NW wardly by a line running N 26 by John Paul's Land, E wardly by common land and a branch of NW wardly by lines running due S & S by land laid out for John Samuel Brew and had such shape form & marks as the above plat represents
