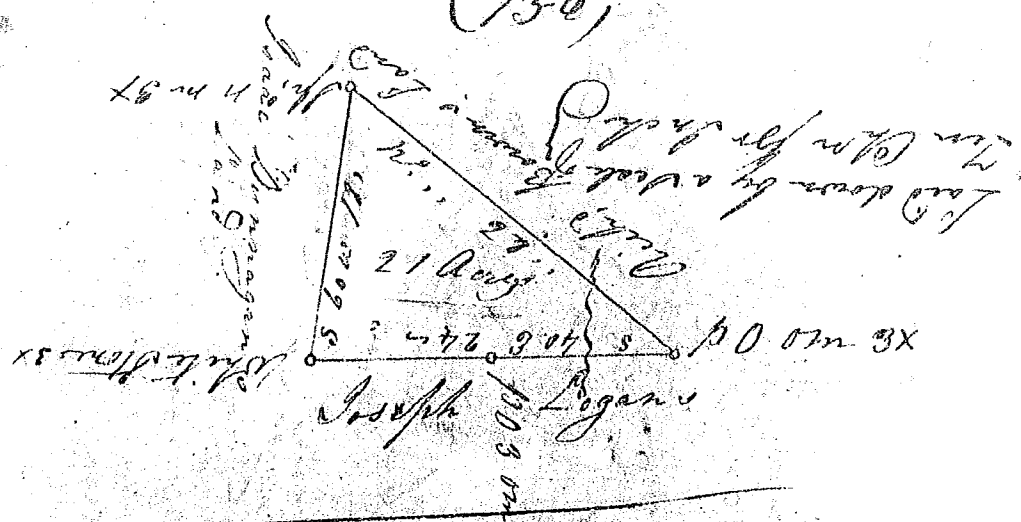

Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esq; Comdr. of Locations for the Greenville District dated the 30th day of January 1817, I have admeasured and laid out unto Richard Bowen a tract of Land containing twenty one Acres, situated in the District and State aforesaid, on a small branch of Saluda River, bounded on the S.E. by a line running S 40 E by Logan's land, by a line running S 60 W by Dunnagan's land, by a line running North by Bowen's land, and hath such bearings and soundings marks and form, as the above Plat represents.
