Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esqr Comr of Locations for Greenville District dated the 4th day of April 1831 I have admeasured and laid out unto Col. John Hodge a tract of Land containing nine hundred and ninety two Acres, situate in said District, on the East side of the North Fork of Saluda River, bounded by said river on the West, and Lewis Spring, S W by S Duham's Land, N W & S W, by said Hodge's Land, and S W by Vacant Land, it being a relocation of lands of former Grants, and hath such form and marks as the above Plat represents.
