Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esqr Commissioner of Locations for Granville District dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 1831. I have Admision and laid out unto John Lightner Esqr a tract of land containing seven hundred and thirteen acres situate in said District, on both sides of Beaverdam Creek of the North fork of Saluda river. Bounded by lines running N<sup>W</sup> by James Southern's Land. ~~to the~~ ~~location of~~ Barkers Land and all other sides on vacant land, it being a relocation of former Grants. and hath such form and marks as the above plat represents. Surveyed April the 23<sup>rd</sup> 1831. John Waldon Esqr. Recorded the 30<sup>th</sup> of May 1831.
