 7th day of June 1831. I have admeasured and laid
 off McKee a tract of land containing twenty
 seven acres, situate in said District on the
 Mountain Creek of Enoree ^{river} and branches, waters
 of Enoree River, bounded by lines running NW &
 SE, East by To Goodlett's Land, NE by W Thompson
 Bart's, SE & NE and North by Manning, Scarishears
 Hess, East and SE & NE by Jos Green's and Saml
 Thompson, SE by Wm Taylor, Henry Pike and John
 Oliver, NW by Hiram Edwards and the said
 Lands, and hath such form and marks as the
 Represents.
