



South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from  
 the General Land Office of the District of  
 Columbia dated the 9th day of Oct 1832 I have  
 measured and laid out in to Joseph Gadsden  
 a tract of Land containing eleven hundred and  
 fifty Acres, situate in said District on both  
 sides of Hodges Mill Creek waters of the North  
 Fork of Saluda River, bounded N by the  
 lot of land 4 1/2 by 1/2 by 1/2 by 1/2 by  
 the said Joseph Gadsden and on the  
 West by vacant land, and half such form &  
 dimensions, surveyed Octo the 16th 1832 by  
 the undersigned and recorded the 1st day of  
 Nov 1832
