Pursuant to a Warrant from Robert M. May, Esq. Es. Commissioner of Locations in the District of Greenville, dated the 17th day of September, 1844. —

I have advanced and laid out unto Stephen H. Peck, a Tract of Land containing Thirty Acres, situated in the said District on a branch of South Tyger River, commonly called the Long Branch, bounded by a line running N. W. by Land surveyed for John S. Westmoreland, N. E. by Land surveyed for Joseph Christie, S. E. by Land surveyed for Joseph M. Millner, and S. W. by Land surveyed for David Bailey, and hath such form, and marks, as the above Plat represents. Given the Twenty fourth day of September, 1844.
