On or about the 23rd day of November, 1971, for value received, the defendants, Bernard L. Phillips and Viola B. Phillips, made, executed and delivered unto the defendant, Harold C. Bowlin, their two promissory notes in writing, both bearing dated of November 23, 1971, and in the principal amounts of Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty-Five and 25/100 (\$8,925.25) Dollars and Eight Thousand, Seven Hundred Eighty-Two and 75/100 (\$8,782.75) Dollars. The terms and provisions of both notes are contained in the attached copies thereof, marked Exhibits A and B, and the contents of said exhibits are hereby incorporated by reference as part of the allegations of this paragraph.

On or about the 17th day of February, 1972, for value received, the defendant, Harold C. Bowlin, assigned and transferred both of said notes to the plaintiff with full recourse.

The plaintiff is the holder of said notes.

Said notes were executed to represent an amount due for the purchase of property in Tennessee, and
