The Plaintiff, complaining of the above-named Defendants, would respectfully show unto the Court:

I.

That the Defendants are citizens and residents of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina.

II.

That on or about August 21, 1973, the Defendants did, for value received, execute and deliver to the Plaintiff their certain Promissory Note in the amount of One thousand five hundred sixty and No/100 Dollars (\$1,560.00) payable in twenty-four (24) consecutive monthly installments of Sixty-five and No/100 Dollars (\$65.00) each, beginning September 21, 1973.
