by and between T.F. McDow

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of eight hundred and 100 dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Just north of the City of Greenville, being designated as lot No. 4 of the division of the Hindman property by survey of R.E. Dalton, Engineer, dated April 17, 1917, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Lucy L. Hindman, said lot being fully described in said deed by cotes and bounds and reference being craved to said deed for a more fully description of said lot. This mortgage is subject to a mortgage executed by me to the Mechanics Prepetual Building & Loan Associaton on May 8th, 1917, said mortgage being recorded in Vol. 000, page 362.
