Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at an iron pin in Whittett street, joint corner of lots numbered one (1) and two (2), thence S. 15° E. along side of said lots one hundred and twenty-six feet, one inch to an iron pin on a ten foot fence, thence N. 76-45 E. along said ally sixty-six feet and eight inches to an iron pin, joint corner of line of lots numbered two (2) and (3), thence N. 50 E. 2W. along joint lines of said lots one hundred and twenty-six feet and one inch to an iron pin on Whittett street, thence S. 76-45 W. along Whittett street Sixty-six feet and eight inches to an iron pin to the beginning corner, this being a portion of Boyce's Addition to Greenville, survey by J. T. Laurence revised January 22, 1908 and known as lot number two (2) "blockly", being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. F. Richardson by Deed dated the 18th day of February, 1918 and recorded in Volume 42, page 303 in P. M. C. office for Greenville County.
