WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two Thousand

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of ~~nine~~  
Eight per cent. per annum, payable

weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

C. office for Greenville County, Plat Books "C" page 520.62, dated March 31, 1914, being a subdivision of the lands of ~~the~~ grantor herein, said lot having the following ~~py~~ <sup>py</sup> metes and bounds: beginning at an iron pipe on the west side of Maccard St. (this point being the southeast corner of lot 720.2, and recasuring 120 ft. from the division line between the ~~inc~~ and Hewell property on Maccard St.) thence S. 21.44.61 ft. along the west side of Maccard St. to an iron pipe in North East corner of lot 720.4, thence along line of last mentioned lot 720.2 173 ft. to an iron pipe in line of lot 720.1, or formerly owned by J.
