WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two Hundred and Sixty Dollars Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at iron pin on A. D. L. Barkedale's lot on Sullivan Street, ~~thence~~ along said Street N. 88.52 W. 75 feet to iron pin in center of alley; thence with center of said alley due N. 162 1/10 feet to iron pin; thence S. 88.52 E. 41 3/10 feet to iron pin at corner of W. G. Shubb's lot; thence S. 11.44 E. 166 2/10 feet to beginning. Alley for joint use of ~~grantor and grantee~~ granted their heirs and assigns and sewer now extending through said property to remain undisturbed.
