Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the first Ward of the City of Greenville, and having the following meter and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Briggz Avenue, and running N. 33 W. one hundred and fifty feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57 W. fifty-seven feet to an iron pin; thence S. 33 E. one hundred and fifty feet to an iron pin on said Briggz Avenue; thence N. 57 E. with said Avenue, fifty-seven feet to the beginning corner; being the same lot of land conveyed to the party of the first part herein by J. P. Burns by deed dated April 4th 1919, and not yet recorded.
