WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of One Hundred Seventy Five (175.00) Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about two miles west of Greenville Court House and being known as lot no. 17 of a subdivision of property known as City View, beginning at a stake in Y.M.C.A. St. two hundred feet from the north west corner of Oreal and Y.M.C.A. Sts. being joint corners of lots nos. 17 and 18 and running thence N. 30 E. along Y.M.C.A. fifty feet to a stake, joint corners of lots nos. 16 and 17; thence with joint lines of said lots in a westerly direction one hundred and fifty ft. to a stake on a ten foot alley; thence in a southerly direction with said alley fifty ft. to a stake on said alley and lot no. 18; thence in an easterly direction with line of lot no. 18 one hundred and fifty feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to me by deed which is recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 44 page 425.
