WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of *Three Thousand Dollars* *of 500 Dollars* *on account*.....

..... *This 2nd day of December* Seven Dollars, money loaned this day with interest thereon from this date at the rate of six per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that certain piece of land, or lot of land, situate, lying
and being in the City of Greenville County and State, afo-
said, on the east side of Rawley Street in the Block North of
~~Park Avenue~~, and known as lot No 2 on a resurvey of City
Park made for, L. B. Traxler Agt. in April 1912 by Will
F. Peeler, Engineer, and having the following metes and
bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Rawley Street
and running thence S 76.30 E one hundred Sixty-six
and 12.5 tenths (166.8) feet along the line of lot No 1 to an
iron pin: thence N 30.30 E fifty two (52) feet to an iron
pin at corner of lot No 3; thence N 76.30 E one hundred
and Seventy-six and six tenths (176.6) feet along the line
of lot No 3 to an iron pin on Rawley Street; thence with
aid Rawley Street S 20-10 fifty (56) feet to the beginning
corner. The same being land purchased by Wilkinson
