by and between J. Walker Bright and Roy G. Bent.

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Twenty Eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000.00) dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of one and one-half per cent. per annum, payable monthly or before the first Friday of each month, every month, weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel & lot of land situated lying and being in Ward One, Greenville City, bought and state aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds to wit; Beginning at a tax now pier on Stone Avenue, joint corner between lots Nos. 14 and 15, and running thence N. 2 - S. E. 18' 8" to a tax now pier on back line of lot No. 12, thence N. 84. 19' W. 28' 5" to a tax now pier in the Western line, lot No. 12, thence S. 21 - 26 W. 15' 4" to a tax now pier; thence N. 84 - 19 W. 30' to a tax now pier corner lots Nos. 13 and 14; thence S. 2. 26 W. 16' 9" to a tax now pier on Stone Avenue, corner lots Nos. 13 and 14; thence along Stone Avenue S. 83. 17 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner, this lot being known and designated as lot No. 14 as shown by a plat of same made by R. C. Lattow, Engineer during the Month of April 1919.
