THIS INDENTURE, made this 9th day of April, A. D. 1920
by and between H. P. McRae,

of Greenville, party of the first part, and the MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars,

~~Interest to be paid weekly~~ Interest to be paid monthly, money loaned this day with interest thereon from this date at the rate of ~~six~~ six per cent. per annum, payable

~~weekly~~ monthly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure. Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of the dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina in the city of Greenville on Stone Avenue, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Stone Avenue, Sixty-five and one-half ($65\frac{1}{2}$) feet from the northwest corner of Stone Avenue and Towee Street Bennett's corner and running thence with Bennett's line N. $5\frac{1}{2}$ E. Two hundred (200) feet to a iron pin, thence N. $84\frac{1}{2}$ W. sixty-five and one-half ($65\frac{1}{2}$) feet to an iron pin, thence S. $8\frac{1}{2}$ W. Two hundred (200) feet to a stake thence S. $84\frac{1}{2}$ E. sixty-five and one-half ($65\frac{1}{2}$) to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to R. W. Lowery by P. O. Thomason by deed dated May 1, 1919 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, Vol. 43 page 530, and conveyed to P. O. Thomason by L. P. Hickman by deed dated February 17th 1919 recorded in Vol. 576 Page 228. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by R. W. Lowery by deed dated February 13th 1920 and recorded in R. M. C. Office in Vol. 57 page 868.
