WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Seven Thousand Eight Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of ~~six~~ eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Perry Avenue in the City of Greenville, corner of lot sold by A. G. and J. Char. Gower to Thomas J. Crane, and run thence with Crane's line to a stake on line of lot #4; thence N. 72 1/4 W. 77 feet 3 inches along line of lot 4 to a stake; thence parallel to first mentioned line 160 feet to Perry Avenue, thence with the line of Perry Avenue S. 72 1/4 E. 77 feet 3 inches to the beginning corner being a part of lots 2 and 3 of the Chick land, plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 497 and is the same land conveyed to me by J. Char. Gower, by deed, dated the 18th day of August 1920, and recorded in Vol. 70 page 100.
