Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents Do Grant, Bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association of Greer,
Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the city of Greer, on the
Northwest side of *Pelham* street.

Beginning at an iron pin on Pelham Street and runs thence \$ 56.00 E.
150 feet to an iron pin, thence \$ 17.00 W. 66.9 feet to an iron pin, thence
