an attorney, which, in addition to said Bond, is hereby secured and made a lien on the premises, as in and by the said Bond and Condition thereof, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said Chas. C. Smith,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, according to the condition of said Bond, and also, in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS to me to said Chas. C. Smith,

in hand, well and truly paid by the said Citizens Building and Loan Association of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

the said Chas. C. Smith, Have Granted,

Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents Do Grant, Bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the city of Greer, on the

South side of Cannon street.

Beginning at an iron pin on Cannon Street, J. M. Woods corner, and running thence S. 7-15- W. 193-5' due to an iron pin, thence S. 84 C. 66 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 7-15- C. 193. 5' feet to an iron pin on Cannon Street, thence with Cannon Street N. 82-43 W. 66 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by M. D. Glenn by deed dated June 2nd, 1920.
