Have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents Do Grant, Bargain, sell and release unto the said **Citizens Building and Loan Association** of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the city of Greer, on the*corner of James Street and Main Street*.....

.....*sixty feet by one hundred and twenty feet, lying lot # 3 in Block no. 1 of J. A. Bannon property and known as Bannon Park according to plat of said land made by St. L.
