Bassell..... in hand, well and truly paid by the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

the said J. E. E. Bassell..... Have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents Do Grant, Bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the city of Greer, on the N. 82-35 E. side of Arlington Ave. street.

Beginning at an iron pin on Arlington Ave., and run thence S. 82-35 E. 110 feet to an iron pin; thence northward at right angles 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 82-35 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence southward at right angles 175 feet to the beginning corner, being designated as lots #17 and #18 on a plat of land made by P. H. Foster, August 6, 1906, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 299 and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. V. Hawkin.
