NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, THAT we the said Oliver W. Hardin and Sallie S. Hardin in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to the said Oliver W. Hardin and Sallie S. Hardin

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville, Cleveland Township, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Designated, as Tract No. 1 on plat of lands of the Estate of W. B. Hardin made by Alonzo L. Edens, Surveyor dated June 5, 1915, said plat being recorded in Plat Book H, page 37, R. M. C. Records for said County, said tract of land contains 0.10 Acres, more or less, and is situate on the New Highway and bounded by lands now or formerly of Monroe Ferguson, W. N. Hardin, Ab. M. Junkin, Harry P. Mc Gee and by the Saluda River, less however, one acre on which is located the Hardin family cemetery and several small tracts aggregating 0.25 Acre, more or less heretofore conveyed by the mortgagors herein.

This being the same tract of land conveyed to Oliver W. Hardin by Sallie S. Hardin by Deed dated June 24, 1915, recorded in Vol. 27, 528 in which she reserves a certain interest in said premises for life, and she now joins in this mortgage, in order to pass a good title to the mortgage.

The above described lands are known as the Hardin Home place, and is the present residence of the mortgagors, reference being made to the above mentioned deed and plat for a more particular description of said lands.
