 1.90 to R. O. 3x; thence $S. 21\frac{1}{2} E. 11.20$ to sycamore on Mill
branch 3x; thence $S. 32 E. 38.00$ with meanderings of said branch
to beginning corner of contiguous 2 1/2 acres more or less and
being tract no. 2 of the former tract of the estate of James
Harvey Cleveland deceased which is more fully described on
plat made by W. C. Hardin Surveyor June 6th, 1893 and being
the same tract of land surveyed to our father P. Mayes
(deceased) by Mary L. Cleveland et al by deed dated January
15th 1893 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County
in Volume 27 page 855 and being devised to us under
the will of the said P. Mayes Cleveland dated September 25th
