Situate lying and being in the city of Greenville in ward no. 5 and on St. John Street about one mile from Greenville Court House, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on north-side of St. John Street, B. D. Smith's corner, and running thence N. 29-15 E. 280 feet with Dr. B. D. Smith's and J. N. Matson's line to corner; thence S. 74-50 E. 80 feet with P. F. Coy's line to corner; thence S. 22-15 W. 272 feet with J. N.
