Situate on the West side of South Main Street in the City of Greenville. Beginning at a point on the West side of said street between Broad Street and Reedy River which beginning point is the northeast corner of a brick building (partially destroyed by fire) now standing on the lot to be conveyed and recd thence parallel with the North Wall of said building N. 69.30 W. 130.83 ft. more or less, to an iron pin in line with rear wall of said building corner of an alley and a court; thence with said Court and the Western face of said building S. 20.30 W. 53 feet to an iron pin, corner of an alley and a court; thence parallel with the south wall of said building S. 69.30 E. 130.83 ft. more or less, a point at the southeast corner of the building, which at a bend in main street, thence with main street N. 20.30 E. 53 ft. to the beginning corner and being known as Lot #6 on plat of Shanks Realty Company and being the same land conveyed to C.
