Situate lying and being on the east side of Augusta Road, and within the corporate limits of the town of Princeton and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone XIII near Black Smiths shop on Augusta Road, and running thence N. 51 1/2 W. 5.80 to stone X III on Danville line; thence N. 52 1/2 E. 17.25 to a stone X III, thence S. 51 1/2 E. 5.80 to a stone X III, thence S. 52 1/2 W. 17.25 to the beginning corner, containing 10 acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Sue J.
