promised to pay ten percent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note.....be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I.....the said *J. W. Lassford**M. R. Bates*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to mein hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *W.A. Wallace*all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

And I own and designated a lot 310.38 of block 12 of Magic Park as shown by plat recorded in R. S. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, page 238, and having the following lines and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on the south side of Tindal Ave. corner of lots 302.37 and 38 and running thence N. 41° 10' E. 150.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89° 07' N. 41° 61 feet to an iron pipe, thence N. 78.21' N. 151.3 feet to an iron pipe on Tindal Ave; thence along Tindal Ave. N. 89.07 E. 61 feet to the beginning corner subject however to the same conditions and reservations as are set forth in a deed from the Magic Park Company to C. D. Wilson dated June 27, 1919 and recorded in Vol. 25 page 402.
