 kind, reference being hereunto had will, fully appear.

 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Thos. J. Charles*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Elmwood*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

About 6 miles south of Greenville Court House, on the White Horse Road, containing 14 acres, more or less, and having the
 following metes and bounds: Beginning on an iron pin
 340m in the White Horse Road, thence N. 29 E. 11.25 chaine
 to a stone 340m; thence N. 2 E. 13.40 chaine to a stone
 340m; thence S. 39 W. 18.95 chaine to an iron pin in White
 Horse Road 340m; thence along said road 10.80 chaine
 to beginning of corner, known as Tract No. 2 on plat made
 by John M. Burton, L. S. in the division of the real
 estate of Pleasant Walker, deceased, and adjoins
