 in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs Lillie Richard

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Austin
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

deeded to B. M. Burdette by Dr. W. N. Acetice on Nov. 14-1877, and
duly recorded in Vol. K 10, page 129 on Jan. 10-1880. The same
being situated on Bigbee Branch, waters of Enoree River
said land said to contain 85 3/4 acres, more or less.

Beginning in a stone 3x0; thence 8.62 3/4 E. 21.50 to
a stone 3x0; thence N. 42 E. 16.30 to a stone 3x0, Emmanuel
Morris, 320w, Charles Morris' corner, along said line 21.
16 1/3 N. 34.50 to a stone 3x0; thence N. 87 1/2 E. 6.40 to a stone
3x0; thence to G. A. Hudson and V. P. Hudson's line to the
