 day of February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November,
 December 1921, January and February, 1922, respectively. Provided that if default
 be made in the payment of said notes, or any one of them or any part thereof,
 according to the terms of said notes, then and in that event the whole amount
 of the said indebtedness, as evidenced by the said notes, shall be come due and
 payable at the option of the holders, or holders thereof, with interest from maturity of said notes
 at the rate of eight per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually
 and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further
 promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any
 kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

On the south side of West Stone Avenue in the City of Greenville and described as follows: Beginning at a stake on said Avenue 42.75 feet from the Northeast corner of Prof. Perry's lot, and runs thence in a southerly direction 262 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a point 41.25 feet from the line of the Perry lot above referred to and in the line of the Perry lot at the rear, thence with Perry's line S. 87 E. 41.25 feet to an iron pin, thence in a northerly direction 261 feet to an iron pin on Stone Avenue; thence along said Avenue N. 84 28' 42.75 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot of land is the east end half of the lot conveyed to A. Katz by Louise Mc Gee Williams on the 10th day of October, 1919, recorded in Book 49, page 265. There is a driveway extending from Stone Avenue into the lot as conveyed by said Williams to said Katz, and situated approximately in the center of said lot, and the center of said driveway will be approximately the line hereinabove designated as running in a southerly direction 262 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet. Said driveway is to remain open for the use of the owner or owners of the lot hereby conveyed, his and their heirs and assigns, and the owner or owners of the remainder of the original lot, his and their heirs and assigns.

This mortgage is junior in rank to a mortgage for four thousand dollars this day executed by me to said Thomas M. Poe to secure the payment of a portion of the purchase price of said lot, this mortgage being also given to secure the payment of part of said purchase price.
