whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Annie P. Posey, her heirs and assigns, all that tract of land aforesaid in Fairview Township County and State aforesaid, beginning at a stone on the road leading from Dr. D. Tally's by the residence of the late Dr. J. B. Person, and run thence S. $73\frac{3}{4}$ E. $16\frac{1}{4}$ to a stone, thence $N. 16\frac{1}{2}$ E. $23\frac{1}{4}$ to a poplar at Tally Branch; thence down said branch to a poplar; thence S. $15\frac{3}{4}$ W. $18\frac{1}{2}$ to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence S. $29\frac{1}{2}$ W. $32\frac{1}{2}$ to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence N. $6\frac{1}{2}\frac{3}{4}$ W. $26\frac{1}{2}$ to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence N. $18\frac{1}{2}$ W. $6\frac{1}{2}$ to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence S. $73\frac{1}{2}$ E. $8\frac{1}{2}$ to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence N. $19\frac{1}{4}$ E. $5\frac{1}{2}$ to the beginning corner, containing 90 acres, more or less, and being the same land conveyed to me by Maggie Peden, by deed recorded in Vol. 39, page 63.
