J. A. Bull, his heirs and assigns, all of my undivided interest being one-fourth, of, in and to, all that lot of land situate on the north west corner, of main and college streets, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina. Beginning at an iron pipe at the intersection of said streets, and run thence along the west side of main street N. 20.29 E. 97.8 feet to an iron pin, corner of Browning property, thence along his line N. 61.22 W. 99.9 feet to an iron pipe on the East side of an alley, thence along the East side of said alley S. 20.37 W. 98.1 feet to a stake on the north side of college street thence along said street S. 61.35 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
