Gallivan: all that Certain piece, parcel of lot of land situate, lying, and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, on the North side of the extension of Augusta street, where it is intersected by Capers Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Augusta Street, and running thence N. 43-39 E., 246.1 feet to corner of Lot No. 50; thence N. 2-08 W., 41.7 feet to corner; thence N. 84 W., 29.8 feet to a pin; thence S. 43-39 W. 21.8 feet to a pin on Capers Street; thence along Capers Street, S. 5-41 E., 70 feet to the beginning corner, being a part of Lot 60 according to plat of Crescent Terrace, said plat being recorded in the R. R. C. Office for Greenville, in plat book E. at page 137. And being the same property conveyed to me, Mollie Syracuse, by E. C. Cass, by deed, dated Nov. 2nd, A.
