Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

On Branch waters of Giddens Creek of Enoree River, being
part of the real estate of P. J. Verdin, deceased, bounded by
lot no 1, Thomas M. Verdin's land and lot no 3, James M.
Verdin land and others, containing by survey of
Wm. P. Gresham 33½ acres, more or less, and having
the following metes and bounds, to wit:
