

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, Harry Moseley
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:
WHEREAS, I, the said Harry Moseley
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the 3rd day of September 1924
am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,
duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of five hundred and no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars,
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 3rd day of Sept. A. D. 1924,
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that
I the said Harry Moseley shall pay or cause to be paid to the said
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of Sept.
1924, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of eight & 33/100
\$8.33 Dollars, (\$8.33 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the five (5) Shares of Stock, and three and 33/100 (\$3.33)
Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the
sum of Seven and 67/100 (\$7.67) Dollars, (\$5.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & 67/100 (\$2.67)
Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Seven and no/100 (\$7.00) Dollars,
(\$5.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & no/100 (\$2.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Six & 33/100 (\$6.33)
Dollars, (\$5.00 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and One & 33/100 (\$1.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the
sum of Five & 67/100 (\$5.67) Dollars, (\$5.00 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Sixty-seven (\$0.67) cents Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)
Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said five (5)
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by I to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made I, the said

said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Harry Moseley
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me
the said Harry Moseley
in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid fronting on North side of Jenkins
Street 87 feet and having a depth of approximately Two hundred (200) feet, and being the
lot whereon I now reside and being same lot conveyed to me by A.C. Davis deed dated December
23rd, 1918 and recorded in Deed Book 44, page 316, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
Said lot is bounded by lots of Ed Dirton and Daisy Walker.
