Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

On the east side of King Street, in Ward One of the City of Greenville land having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on King Street corner of lot formerly owned by H. A. Newbold and running thence S. 34 1/4 E. 170 feet to stake thence N. 55 3/4 E. 60 feet to a stake thence N. 34 1/4 W. 170 feet to a stake on King Street and thence along King Street S. 55 3/4 W. 60 feet to beginning corner containing 10,200 square feet more or less, and being designated as Lot No. 8 on plat made by Jas. K. Dickson, D. S. and recorded in office of R. M.
