Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville Township, record the Millside Cotton Mill, in a subdivision known as Dogwood and being known and designated as lot No. 55 on plat of said subdivision made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, which plat is recorded in R. S. L. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, Pages 462 and 463, said lot having a frontage on Larkdal Street of 50 feet and runs back a depth of 150 feet and has such courses and distances as are shown on said plat, being the same conveyed to Ora Locke by A. Louise Heyward, as executrix, by deed dated January 4, 1924, recorded in Vol 90 Page 246.
