WHEREAS, I, the said F. E. Hood, in and by my certain instrument of conveyance, even date with these presents, C. L. Greenville Robert L. Ashmore of deceased note to witness of well and truly indebted to the in the full and just sum of \$1,000.00, in the month of November, 1926, recd. of A. L. Ashmore, carried under the Dollars, to be paid on the 25th day of November, 1926, with interest thereon, from the 25th day of November, 1926, at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid each November 25th thereafter until paid in full; and interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of a reasonable amount, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Hood, in hand well and truly held by the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. L. Smith all that certain tract of land aforesaid, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, beginning at corner of grantor H. B. Hood and land now or formerly of Birmingham, thence with Birmingham land, N. 77.00 E. 5.33 to an iron pin, thence N. 82 1/2 E. 4.00 to the junction of ditch and a branch thence S. S. 13.00 W. 1.10 to a spring in the branch thence with land now or formerly of Jas. Hudson N. 77.00 E. 27.40 to a point in a meander of said creek, thence N. 82 1/2 E. 15.0 to black gum on old creek bank now or formerly of Earle Painter. Then N. 82 1/2 E. 15.0 to a point in old creek bank now or formerly of Lewis Haltclaw, thence up to the meanderings of said creek to a point 1.50 in a easterly direction from the junction of Brushy Creek and a branch, also the dividing line of lands of C. D. Hood and F. E. Hood. thence S. 42 1/4 E. 18.80 to the point of beginning. Being a part of land conveyed to C. D. & F. E. Hood by R. L.
