SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said *M. L. (Pharis)* in and by *One* certain *present* day *January*, *19*⁰ even date with these presents, is well and truly indebted to *Emmie A. Mackstas, widow of John Mackstas, and Trustee* in the full and just sum of *Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)* to be paid at the rate of *Six Percent (\$6.00)* per month from date and interest accrued thereon to be paid three months thereafter until paid in full; and also to *anticipate* interest on the principal amount so paid at the rate of *Eight Percent (\$8.00)* per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly* *beginning* *September*, *19*⁰ *and thereafter to* *until paid in full*; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10% of the amount*.
