a corporation, its successors and assigns, all that  
certain piece, parcel and tract of land in  
Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South  
Carolina, containing 122.40 acres, more or less,  
bounded on the north by lands of S.D. Knight  
on the East by lands of O.L. Huff and S.E.  
Harrison, on the South by lands of S.E. Harrison and  
W.H. Harrison and on the West by Reedy River and across  
the River to lands of Earnest Huff and Willie Baker, as  
shown upon a plat of same by W.J. Riddle, surveyor  
dated December 2nd, 1922, and being made up of  
two tracts of land, one containing 50 acres, conveyed  
to Henry W. Durant by L.L. Richardson, by deed dated Jan  
8, 1910, and another containing 70-1/5 acres conveyed to  
Henry Durant by W.J. Alexander by deed dated Nov. 16, 1905  
Also another tract of land in Fairview Township, County  
and State aforesaid, containing 112.17 acres more or less,  
located on waters of Reedy River and Cupper Creek, bounded  
on the north by lands of S.E. Harrison on the East by lands  
of S.C. and Robert Harrison, on the South by lands of
