until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for attorney's fee of 10%

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the, the said E. E. Watson,

in hand well and truly paid by the said Elizabeth Isbell

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents,

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elizabeth Isbell, and her heirs, and assigns,

all of the following real estate herein described:

1st. - all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, on the Rutherford Road, and having the following mites and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Rutherford Road, and running thence N. 22-15 W. 336.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 64-37 E. 180.5 feet to an iron pin on alley; thence S. 22.08 E. 341.7 feet to an iron pin on Rutherford Road; thence with said Rutherford Road S. 81-24 W. 186 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 1.42 acres, more or less;

2nd. - also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County Aforesaid, and having the following mites and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone, Jack Scott's land and running thence N. 68-37 E. 149.1 feet to a stone on line of lot last above described; thence N. 25-15 W. 258.4 feet to an iron pin on alley; thence S. 70-50 W. 154.5 feet to an iron pin on alley, corner of Jack Scott's land; thence S. 019-04 E. P. Mcgee, W. P. Congre and W. T. Henderson, Trustees of W. T. Irvin Estate by deed dated March 17, 1917 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in volume 40 at page 274.
